

PUBLIC USE OF SCHOOL BUSES

1. Transportation of Pupils: The present licensing regulations of the State of Wisconsin do not allow the use of a vehicle carrying a regular school bus registration plate for any purpose other than transporting pupils to and from school and extra-curricular activities. Out-of-school groups such as Boy Scouts, 4-H Clubs, etc., cannot be transported in these vehicles, and even school pupils cannot be transported by outside sponsors unless the school has an education interest in the trip. "Weight Plate Stickers" required of bus contractors doing charter work are not available to schools.
2. Transportation of Parents for Extra Curricular Activities: The Granton Area School District will provide transportation for parents and guardians of pupils, and authorized chaperons for approved extracurricular activities whenever transportation for such activities is provided to pupils and space is available. Transportation of pupils will receive priority to transportation of parents and guardians. The district will not provide transportation for approved extracurricular activities for parents and guardians only.

Any parent or guardian provided transportation under this policy shall comply with all applicable school rules and with the directives of the district's agent supervising the transportation. Non-compliance may result in the denial of transportation or other sanctions as appropriate.

At the discretion of the Board, a fee sufficient to reimburse the district for the cost of providing such transportation shall be paid by the persons transported.
