

**DEFIBRILLATION PROGRAM – PUBLIC ACCESS**

The Board of Education has determined that it may enhance school safety to have an automated external defibrillator (AED) placed in the school.

An AED is a heart monitor and defibrillator that:

- A. Is capable of recognizing the presence or absence of ventricular fibrillation or rapid ventricular tachycardia and determining without intervention by an operator, whether defibrillation should be performed;
- B. Charges and, at the command of the operator, delivers an electrical impulse to an individual's heart.

An appropriate number of staff will be trained to use automated external defibrillators in an effort to have qualified personnel available if needed.
