

SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM

1. The breakfast/lunch prices for students and adults shall be reviewed and/or established by the Board of Education prior to the beginning of each school year. Prices are subject to change at any time by the Board of Education if deemed necessary.
2. Free and reduced breakfasts/lunches shall be offered in accordance to State and Federal regulations. Reduced lunch prices shall be reviewed and/or established by the Board of Education prior to the beginning of each school year and shall not exceed the maximum price established by State or Federal regulations.
3. When an individual account is at \$5.00 or less, or a family account is at \$15.00 or less, a note to the parent(s) will be sent home with the student, or mailed, as a reminder that the account is getting low.

Parent(s) are notified when the account is in the arrears, indication that additional money must be added to the account in order to continue receiving breakfast/lunch for the student(s). Accounts due should not be allowed to exceed one week, and when it does, the parent(s) shall be asked to send a sack lunch for their child(ren).

4. Students who qualify for free breakfast/lunch shall not be denied participation in the program because of an outstanding account.
