

**STUDENTS AT RISK**

The Granton Area School District recognizes that some students are "at risk" of not completing their public school educational program. The school district will make a concerted effort to identify these students at the earliest possible time and establish a written plan of intervention to prevent premature exit from school in accordance with Wisconsin Statute 118.153.

The Granton Area School District C-A-R (Children At Risk) Coordinator will be the district administrator, with the building C-A-R coordinator being the high school principal. The district will establish a C-A-R advisory committee to monitor C-A-R activity. The school administration, guidance personnel or other designated personnel will provide the supervision of all school educational and non-educational C-A-R programs. The C-A-R personnel will monitor one on one student supervision/evaluation with all C-A-R placements.
