

DEFINITION OF A FULL TIME STUDENT

1. Full Time Elementary Student (Grades Pre-school through Grade 5)
 - A. The child meeting the age requirement as defined by the State of Wisconsin who is registered and in regular attendance in the appropriate grade level program that operates daily under the established time schedule.
 - B. Pre-school and kindergarten students in attendance on a half day or full day basis which is considered full time for these grade levels, but subject to state definition with regard to state reporting, may be classified as part time or full time.
 - C. A student who has been classified by appropriate IEP team procedure as EEN and in attendance in a state approved EEN program.
 - D. Students receiving home bound instruction under the supervision and direction of an instructor designated by the school for this purpose. Full time home bound instruction is defined as instructional effort adequate to maintain education progress which could reasonably be expected if the student were in regular school attendance, or that prescribed by appropriate IEP team procedure.
2. Full Time Middle School Student (Grades 6 – 8)
 - A. A student registered and in regular attendance in six or more units of instruction in an eight period day. A unit of instruction shall be defined as a course of instruction, meeting daily for a prescribed period of time as described on a school board approved class schedule.
 - B. A student who has been classified by appropriate IEP team procedure as EEN and in attendance in a state approved EEN program.
 - C. Students receiving home bound instruction under the supervision and direction of an instructor designated by the school for this purpose. Full time home bound instruction is defined as instructional effort adequate to maintain educational progress which could reasonably be expected if the student were in regular school attendance, or that prescribed by appropriate IEP team procedure.
3. Full Time Senior High Student (Grades 9 – 12)
 - A. A student scheduled for 6 or more credits in a school year.
 - B. A student who has been classified by appropriate IEP team procedure as EEN and in attendance in a state approved EEN program.
 - C. Students receiving home bound instruction under the supervision and direction of an instructor designated by the school for this purpose. Full time home bound instruction is defined as instructional effort adequate to maintain educational progress which could reasonably be expected if the student were in regular school attendance, or that by appropriate IEP team procedure.
 - D. Exceptions to these requirements may be made for students with special needs or students classified as at risk.
