POLICY CODE: Chapter 10; Section PB

PRIVACY IN LOCKER ROOMS

The Granton Area School District shall take the following reasonable measures to protect the privacy rights of individuals using the school locker rooms.

- 1. Locker rooms are provided for the use of physical education students, athletes, and other activity groups and individuals authorized by the building principal or by District policy.
- 2. No one will be permitted to enter into or remain in the locker room to interview or seek information from any individual student or coach before, during, or after any school sponsored athletic event or practice. Such interviews may take place outside of the locker room consistent with District policy and school rules.
- 3. No cameras, video recorders, or other devices that can be used to record or transfer images may be used in the locker room at any time.
- 4. No person may use a cell phone to capture, record, or transfer a representation of a nude or partially nude person in the locker room or to take any other photo or video image of a person in the locker room.

Students and staff found to be in violation of this policy shall be subject to school disciplinary action and possible legal referral, if applicable. Other persons violating the policy may be subject to penalties outlined in state law. The building principal or his/her designee shall be responsible for enforcing this policy.

This policy shall be posted in every school locker room in the District and publicized annually.
