## **GRANTON AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD POLICY**

POLICY CODE: Chapter 11; Section C

## **COMMUNITY USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES**

The building and properties of the school district shall be available for community use under the conditions prescribed or permitted by law and in accordance with the adopted policies of the Board of Education.

The Board of Education may grant special requests, waive the fee, demand additional regulations and/or fee, or refuse the use of any or all school facilities to any applicant as deemed desirable for allowing proper usage and maintaining adequate safeguards.

Organizations or individuals wishing to schedule use of school facilities will make application for approval to the District Administrator prior to using the facilities. Application will be denied if previous usage has been detrimental.

The following order shall be used in determining priority of use for applicants:

- 1. Any school function connected with the educational program or any of the school sponsored activities.
- 2. Adult education classes approved by the Administrator and/or School Board.
- 3. Resident organizations or individuals of the district.

4. All other organizations or individuals not included in above.

In order to be approved, activities sponsored by non-school organizations must not be for commercial use which will result in personal gain or profit. In general, all such meetings must be open to the public and no discrimination is to be shown. No equipment shall be loaned for use by individuals, non-school organizations or employees unless approved by the Administrator.
