SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM

- The breakfast/lunch prices for students and adults shall be reviewed and/or established by the Board of Education prior to the beginning of each school year. Prices are subject to change at any time by the Board of Education if deemed necessary.
- Free and reduced breakfasts/lunches shall be offered in accordance to State and Federal regulations. Reduced lunch prices shall be reviewed and/or established by the Board of Education prior to the beginning of each school year and shall not exceed the maximum price established by State or Federal regulations.
- 3. When an individual account reaches a negative balance, a note to the parent(s) will be sent home with the student, or mailed, as a reminder that the account is negative.

Parent(s) are notified when the account is in the arrears, indicating that additional money must be added to the account in order to continue receiving breakfast/lunch for the student(s).

4. Students who qualify for free breakfast/lunch shall not be denied participation in the program because of an outstanding account. Students will not be allowed second entrees or ala carte purchases when their account is negative.
