POLICY CODE: Chapter 5; Section B

EMERGENCY CARE POLICIES

- 1. An advisory committee composed of the Principal, county health nurse and a doctor acting as medical advisor to the Granton School District, will plan and implement the school health safety program.
- 2. The advisory committee will be responsible for reducing the number of accidents and injuries through development and implementation of an emergency medical service.
- 3. The school will have detailed written procedures for handling all anticipated emergencies including parental approval for transportation and emergency medical service.
- 4. The School Board will contract, for emergency nursing service, from the Clark County Nursing Service, under the direction of the Clark County Medical Advisor.
- 5. All school employees shall be made aware of the Granton Area Schools Emergency Medical Procedures. The emergency medical guidelines provide specific staff directions for apparent injury or apparent illness situations. Designated personnel within the school should be contacted to assist with emergency medical procedures. The personnel are school administrators, office personnel, physical education instructors and/or athletic coaches.
- 6. The School Board shall provide opportunities for all school employees to be inserviced in emergency medical procedures which shall include instruction in basic first aid techniques.
