TOBACCO, NICOTINE OR ELECTRONIC CIGARETTE USE ON SCHOOL PREMISES

Evidence points to serious health hazards for users of tobacco or nicotine products and for those subjected to tobacco smoke. Youngsters tend to model adult behavior. To comply with 1989 Wisconsin Act 209, it shall be the policy of the Board of Education to:

- 1. Prohibit use of all tobacco products in all buildings, property, and on any school grounds, playing field or other outdoor area owned, rented by, or under control of the Granton Area School District.
- 2. Employees and the public will be informed of the no tobacco or nicotine products policy by signs at the entrance of buildings, on grounds, and the district newsletter.

It shall also be a violation of this policy for any student, employee, or visitor to use, possess, consume, display, or sell tobacco, nicotine, or electronic cigarettes at any time on school property or at off-campus school sponsored events.

STUDENT VIOLATIONS

EMPLOYEE VIOLATIONS

- 1. Verbal warning
- 2. Conference with the Principal and/or District Administrator with a written reprimand placed in personnel file
- 3. Conferences with the District Administrator, one day suspension without pay, and a written reprimand placed in personnel file.
- 4. Conference with the Board of Education and District Administrator, a two day suspension without pay, and a written reprimand placed in personnel file
- 5. Conference with the Board of Education to consider termination of employment

RESIDENT/VISITOR VIOLATION

- 1. Verbal warning
- 2. Contact law enforcement

In case of a supervisor, Principal or Administrator, violations are to be reported to Board members with the above steps being followed. The Board will substitute for the Principal or District Administrator in the above steps.
