GRANTON AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD POLICY

POLICY CODE: Chapter 9; Section A

THE SCHOOL YEAR

The Board of Education recognizes that the preparation of a calendar for the instructional program of the school is necessary for the orderly planning and the efficient operation of the District. The school calendar shall be prepared by the District Administrator and approved by the Board of Education.

The school year calendar shall show starting and ending dates of the school year and such days when school will be closed for vacations.

The Board shall determine annually the total number of days when school will be in session for instructional purposes. The Board will strive to set the school year calendar with 180 direct student contact days. The minimum number of hours of student instruction shall comply with the hours required by statute.
