

BOARD-DISTRICT ADMINSTRATOR RELATIONSHIPS

While the Board of Education of the Granton Area Schools is charged by the state with the responsibility for providing educational opportunities for the children of its schools and of directing those public school activities which the state entrusts to its care and supervision, a carefully planned pattern of authority is observed by the Board. In fulfilling its obligations, the Board acts similarly in its relationships to the schools as do boards of directors to successful business organizations; that, through the power of legislation by the determination of policies, and the evaluation of results. The direct administration of the school system is delegated to the School District Administrator whom the Board appoints to act as executive officer of the Board. The Administrator may delegate a principal of the district to be in charge upon the Administrators absence from the district. The Administrator is held individually and directly responsible to the Board for the execution of all its policies and its legislation and for such other duties assigned by the Board.
