

Granton Equestrian Club

The Granton Equestrian Club was established in 2018 to promote horsemanship education for all students in grades 6 through 12. The club also has an equestrian team that competes in the Wisconsin Interscholastic Horsemanship Association (WIHA) annual competition at the district and/or state level.

Participation on the Granton Equestrian Team offers you the opportunity to receive a letter/recognition for your work at the annual sports banquet. Each student must:

- Complete ALL athletic forms and submit them to the District Office.
 - Athletic code
 - Concussion form
 - Transportation release
 - Physical evaluation by doctor
- Pay \$35 Athletic Fee for the current academic year.
- Participate in a minimum of 3 horse shows between May – October of the current academic year.
 - Submit required documentation by October 1 of current academic year.
 - Horse shows could include: breed shows, Clark County Pleasure Rider shows, county fair, etc.
 - Judges must be Wisconsin Horse Council certified
 - “Fun Shows” without carded judges will not count for the requirements.
- Participate in the Wisconsin Interscholastic Horsemanship Association (WIHA) District show of the current academic year and if the team qualifies, you MUST compete in the State show.
- Attend and actively participate in the club meetings at school.
- Train with your horse a minimum 20 hours per month and submit required documentation by November 1 of each academic school year.
