Instructional Educator Expectations for Remote Learning

Protocols for All Students:

- Google Classroom will be used to post videos and assignments.
- Google Meets and/or Zoom will be used for live class streaming.
- Classtag will be used to communicate with parents/guardians.
- Teachers are expected to make videos or go live with instruction according to the following schedules. These live videos and recordings will be saved to Google Classroom.
Elementary, MS & HS Remote Instructional Schedules listed below
- Teachers will give daily feedback and communication with students in their classes.
- Grading expectations will remain the same for all classes below, just as in-person learning this 2020-2021 school year.
- SPED and Title services will still be provided to those students who have been receiving them.
- Breakfast/Lunch will be provided through the district. If you are interested in receiving meals for any members of your household age 18 or younger, please contact Char Johnson directly at 715-238-5132.

Virtual Student Expectations

- Show up for **all** class google meets/Zoom on time and be an active participant.
- Reach out if you are having device/internet issues as soon as possible.
- Have your ***mic muted***.
- Ask for help when you need it (during the class google meets is best).
 - Take advantage of teacher office hours if you have questions.
 - Otherwise send your teacher a polite email if you need extra help.
- Stay caught up on your work.
- All assignments are expected to be completed and turned in on time. Grading will remain the same as in-person learning. The Grading Policy is attached.
- MS and HS Students: Every day you will join the Homeroom google meet to show your teacher that you are logging in for the day. This is a great time to get support as well. You will have to show up to the meet between 8:15-8:25am. Otherwise you will be considered absent.

Elementary Remote Learning

Grades 4K

- Supplementary packets will be sent home on a bi-weekly basis.
- Zoom will occur once a week and videos will be recorded/placed on Google Classroom.
- **Language Arts** - 4-5 times a week
- **Math** - 4-5 times a week
- **Science/Social Studies** - 2 times per week

Grades K-5

- Supplementary packets will be sent home in grades K-2 in addition to their device.
- Teachers will be live during their scheduled time and pre-recorded videos will also be used as supplementary instruction.
- **Math**-Must teach 3 lessons each week with 3-4 assignments a week. (Think Central Personal Math Trainer, Quick Quizzes, Test)
- **Social Studied/Science**-You will teach either S.S. or Science each week. Expectations are one lesson a week. This includes reading the text, answering the questions and completing the lesson check. (Interactive Science, Studies Weekly Newspaper)
- **Writing**-Writing instruction must take place 3 times per week with at least one writing assignment given and returned with feedback.
- **Reading**-Reading must be taught 4 days a week. This could be ReadyGen and/or Guided Reading. Skills/Strategies must be taught. It is not just reading a book silently.
- **Spelling**-Spelling will be taught and assessed bi-weekly.
- **Specials**-Keyboarding and Art will be sending out bi-weekly assignments. Phy-Ed, Music and Library Skills will send out 1 assignment each week.
- *****These are minimum requirements and could be lengthen depending on the needs of each specific grade level/subject area*****

- **Lit**-4 days a week with 3-4 assignments
- **Comp**-2 days a week (1-2 lessons) with 1-2 assignments
- **SS and Science**-2 days a week (1 lesson) with 1-2 assignments
- **Specials (Music/Phy.Ed)**- One lesson a week plus a log with activities.
- No Enrichments or Rotations.
- Study Hall and Support Rooms may be created for any students in need of more individualized one-on-one support.
